VII.	Notes for Video	A. The video must be recorded within three months of the application deadline.
	Screening	B. The video must be shot without cuts, with the two pieces played in succession, with
		a fixed camera and in landscape mode.
		C. The applicant's name must be included in the title of the video.
		D. Do not delete the video until notification of the Document and Video screening results.
		E. After notification of the results, each applicant must delete the video themselves.
		F. The video must be unedited. (If the video is deemed edited, it will not be considered for screening)
